The adoption of a nationwide plumbing standard and implementation of supporting programs will benefit Indonesian citizens by improving plumbing systems in their households, as well as their cities and villages. To that end, the IAPMO Group and the National Standardization Agency of Indonesia (BSN) have been working together to develop and implement an Indonesian National Standard (SNI) for plumbing products through adoption of the *Uniform Plumbing Code (UPC®)*. The introduction of an internationally recognized *UPC®* in SNI will not only assist in protecting the health and safety of Indonesia's citizens through the safe delivery of water via properly installed and certified products, but will further provide a level playing field for all manufacturers by providing the necessary capacity building and technical assistance for enforcement.
